COMPETITION REGULATIONS

CHAPTER I - DEFINITION OF THE COMPETITION

1. OBJECT OF THE COMPETITION

ANAS announces an international Competition, with an open procedure, aimed at the realisation of a design project for the definition and design of a type of "**overpass**" to be used for the different junctions or road intersections at split-level present on ANAS road network.

The guidelines for the design, with the description of the contents and objectives, are given in the Preliminary Design Document (hereinafter, referred to as PDD), hereto attached and an integral part of these Regulations.

1. TOPICS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

The topics of the Competition are divided into MAIN TOPICS and RELATED TOPICS

The MAIN TOPICS which the Competition relates to are as follows:

- A. To identify technical solutions for the overpasses of the ANAS motorway and road network adaptable and applicable to the different needs arising in the design of individual works.
- B. To identify solutions featuring important architectural elements.
- C. To give a uniform and recognizable image to the different types of ANAS roads.

The RELATED TOPICS which the Competition relates to are as follows:

- A. To enhance and promote forms of design research into the field of roads in Italy, characterized by important environmental-landscape elements through integrated and joint actions.
- B. Integrated design with the surrounding context.
- C. Environmental communication for the management of environmental and territorial conflicts.

2. ESTIMATED COST OF THE WORKS TO BE DESIGNED

Maximum cost of the design proposal for the type of "overpass" for individual infrastructures including ramps and associated elements must be equal to:

- € 1,500,000.00 (excluding VAT and foundation work) for ordinary overpasses;
- € 3,000,000.00 (excluding VAT and foundation work) for junction overpasses.

Before proceeding to the second phase, which entails the application of the concept and the development of the project in an area of reference to be chosen, the maximum cost of the works will be estimated.

The cost of the proposal - also with regard to its operation and maintenance - will be among the qualifying factors.

2. STRUCTURE OF THE PROCEDURE

The Competition will be carried out through an open procedure, divided into two phases:

- > the **first phase**, in anonymous form, for the technical proposal, is aimed at selecting the best design proposals up to a maximum of 10 (ten) to be admitted to the following phase;
- ➤ in the second phase, in non-anonymous form, the best design project from those previously selected (max. of 10) will be chosen.

2.1 AREA OF REFERENCE

The area of reference for testing the application of the "concept" and the development of the project will be chosen, at the end of the first phase of the Competition, among the ANAS works which present along their extension a good considerable number of different types of intersection with other related crossing roads, to be solved through the use of overpasses.

The area of reference will be selected among those listed in the Main routes included in the ANAS Multiannual Plan 2015-2019 By way of a non-limiting example among the main initiatives undertaken under the New Works and Completion of routes, the Plan provides for the completion of the A3 Salerno-Reggio Calabria, priority works along the SS 106 "Jonica", the completion of the SS 182 "delle Serre Calabre," the completion of the Grosseto-Siena on the Grosseto-Fano section, priority works for the Malpensa Airport accessibility system; priority works along the SS 9 "Via Emilia"; rationalization and expansion works on Rome's main ring road.

In the second phase of the Competition, the competitor will have to demonstrate the applicability of the proposal.

An inspection, if deemed necessary, may be arranged in the area of reference with the finalists admitted to the seminar. In developing the project, the competitors should take into account any recommendations made by the Selection Panel at the end of the first phase of the Competition and at the seminar.

CHAPTER II - PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

3. SUBJECTS ADMITTED TO THE COMPETITION: ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All those subjects pursuant to art. 90 of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements, paragraph 1, letters d, e, f, f-bis, g, h, in compliance with the requirements set forth by the aforesaid article and the additional requirements set forth in the tender documents, with particular reference to the specific limits and bans on participation legally provided for under penalty of exclusion from the Competition, are eligible to participate.

Professionals employed by Public Bodies must attach the specific authorization to participate in the Competition issued by the related Body.

Participation is open to professionals from the Member States of the European Union, enrolled in the related Professional Associations under the laws of the State to which they belong and to those possessing a qualification to practice in Italy, who have not been prohibited from practising their profession at the date of publication of the Notice.

Competitors may avail of collaborators and consultants lacking the technical requirements for admission, but who must not find themselves in any of the conditions of incompatibility referred to in para. 4 below or in any of the cases of exclusion referred to in points a4), a5), a9) as in para. 9. Such consultants need not be registered in the Professional registers. The qualifications of each individual consultant or collaborator and the nature of the advice or collaboration must be declared. Tasks and duties of the consultants and/or collaborators are defined within the competitor group without such having any significance for the relations between the competitor and ANAS.

The Contracting Body is exempt of any responsibility regarding relations within the group.

In view of the multidisciplinary nature of the object of the Competition, each designer or group of designers must, necessarily, integrate their skills with those of professionals, researchers and experts in relation to specific issues. In detail, the design team must consist of at least:

a designer responsible for the integration between the various specialist services (architect or
engineer) - group chief;
an expert in structures (architect or engineer);
an expert in geological and geotechnical design (geologist or engineer);
an expert in energy conservation and sustainable architecture;
an expert landscape designer (architect, engineer, agronomist-forester, geologist);
an expert in participatory processes and analysis of urban and territorial systems (architect, urban
planner, sociologist, anthropologist).

These consultants need not be registered in the Professional registers.

In accordance with the provisions of article 253, paragraph 5 of Presidential Decree 207/2010, at least 20% of the members of the design team should be composed of professional graduates who have qualified to practice less than five years earlier.

The professional qualification of each professional must be proven by means of registration in the relevant professional register and presentation of his/her CV.

Temporary groupings constitute a single entity for the purposes of the Competition and the authorship of the project proposal presented will be recognised, with equal rights and ownership to all members of the group.

3.1 ANONYMITY

The anonymity of the participants, with regard to the examination of the technical proposals presented, is guaranteed for the entire duration of the first phase of the Competition, also by making use of the IT services and applications provided, in accordance with art. 290 of Presidential Decree 207/10 and subsequent amendments and supplements, by the operator of the platform. The operator of the platform appointed by ANAS is BRAVOSOLUTION SPA.

4. CAUSES OF INCOMPATIBILITY

The following may not enter the Competition:

- 1. Those who have participated in drafting the Notice of Competition, the Regulations and of any additional documents attached to it;
- 2. Employees of ANAS and the subjects, who, at the date of publication of the Notice of Competition, have a relationship of any kind with ANAS concerning the issues or areas in any way related to the subject of the Competition;
- 3. The acting members and substitutes of the Selection Panel;
- 4. Spouses, relatives and the like up to the third degree inclusive and anyone having a work relationship with the subjects mentioned in points 1 to 3.

5. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

By participating in the Competition, the competitors agree, without reservation, to all the rules contained in the Notice of Competition and these Regulations

Failure to comply with its terms will result in automatic exclusion from the Competition.

6. COMPETITION DOCUMENTS

ANAS provides the following documentation which can be downloaded free of charge in the dedicated section of the ANAS Purchases portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it in the section related to the Competition (accessible after registration):

SECOND PHASE

The documentation related to the second phase will be defined and made available once the selected reference area and route have been identified within the ANAS network with regard to the implementation of the Multiannual Plan 2015-2019 in order to verify the applicability of the ideas proposed.

7. QUERIES AND REQUESTS FOR CLARIFICATION

Those presenting proposals may submit requests for clarification to ANAS using exclusively the "messages" function of the online Request for Proposals related to the phase of the Competition in progress, **after registering on the portal** https://acquisti.stradeanas.it following the procedures set out in detail in paragraph 9 of these regulations. Questions relative to registration and administrative documentation, as well as those concerning the submission of the documents, should be made by **1.00 pm** on **07.01.2016** (Rome local time).

ANAS S.p.A declines any responsibility resulting from failure to respond to any request for clarification received other than as described in this paragraph.

8. PHASE ONE - PRESENTATION OF THE DOCUMENTS

The project proposal required for participation in the first phase of the Competition, must comprise the following documents:

- Introductory Report (composed of a maximum of 10 pages in UNI A4 format in Arial font size 10 on vertically oriented PDF files): this document should indicate criteria inspiring the design choices made in relation to the objectives set out in the Regulations;
- 2. **Drawings** composed of 4 (four) tables (in UNI AI format on PDF files oriented horizontally): these documents should illustrate the proposed solution to enable a full assessment by the Selection Panel.
- 3. **Descriptive report** (composed of a maximum of 10 pages in UNI A4 format in Arial font size 10 on vertically oriented PDF files): this document should contain a description of the project characteristics in terms of its inclusion in possible reference contexts and relations with the surrounding built area.

On each document, **under penalty of exclusion**, no references should be present enabling the attribution of a name to the individual drawings or reports to one of the competitors.

The required documents must bear <u>exclusively</u> the wording "Concorso di progettazione - Reinventa Cavalcavia", placed in a rectangle 80/10mm in the upper right corner of each document.

All document files must be printable and not individually exceed the size of 50 MB.

Additional documents, or documents different from those indicated in these Regulations are not allowed, **under penalty of exclusion**

9. PHASE ONE - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

To enter the Competition, the entities registered and authorised on the Purchases portal of ANAS S.p.A must submit the documentation requested, within the obligatory deadline set out in point IV.4.3) of the Notice of Competition, solely by electronic means through the portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it, as indicated in detail in the following paragraph 9.1.

Participants must produce and digitally sign, **under penalty of exclusion**, the statements/documents indicated below, made pursuant to articles 19, 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/00, as last amended by art. 15, paragraph 1, of law 12/11/2011, no. 183 (Stability Law 2012), by the Candidate (single professional, legal representative of the candidate or subject having the appropriate powers - Single participant or member of a Group), accompanied by a photocopy of a valid identity document and the necessary documents to prove the office and powers of signature of the individual signing and of the persons specified in the following points, also accompanied by a photocopy of a valid identity document.

Each statement should contain, in addition to the reference as in point **IV.4.1** of the Notice of Competition, an indication of all the elements needed for the retrieval of information and data which such statements relate to, and for the location of the related documents held by public authorities, in order to allow the Contracting Authority to carry out, where the preconditions exist, the official investigations as per art. 43, paragraph 1, and the controls as per art. 71 of the Presidential Decree 445/2000, as amended by art. 15, paragraph 1, of law 12/11/2011, no 183.

The declarations required of external collaborators/consultants indicated by the competitor must be made by the latter and signed with handwritten signature. In this case the Candidate (Single professional, legal representative of the candidate or subject having the appropriate powers -Single participant or member of a Group) will acquire the scanned copies of the aforesaid statements and endorse them digitally in the same manner as outlined above.

- **a)** The candidate (Single participant or member of a Group) must, in support of the application submitted in the manner provided for in section 9.1 of these regulations, declare/produce/attest/certify and digitally sign:
 - a.1) The name and the registration in the relevant professional register of the designer/s presenting the design proposal. In the case of professional employees of Public Bodies, specific authorization to participate in the Competition from the relevant body;
 - a.2) insofar as applicable by virtue of the legal status of the candidate, registration with the Chamber of Commerce indicating for which activities the Company is registered, Companies Register number or Economic and Administrative Index no, registration number, registration date, duration of the company / end date, legal form, registered office of the company (location / postcode address), Tax code number, VAT number, name/s (with position, date of birth and place of birth and residence as well as tax code number) of the owner, partners, technical directors, directors with powers of representation and general partners or the sole shareholder natural person, or the majority shareholder in the case of companies with less than four shareholders wherever the same is a natural person;

In the case of a Candidate belonging to another Member State not resident in Italy, a deed or equivalent declaration of registration in professional and trade registers, pursuant to art. 39, paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements.

- a.3) insofar as applicable by virtue of the legal status of the candidate, the list of Technical Directors in office, indicating name/s (with position, date of birth and place of birth and residence, as well as tax code number) at the time of submitting the application form;
- a.4) under penalty of exclusion, that he/she is in none of the conditions provided for by Art. 38, paragraph 1, letters a) to m-ter) of Legislative Decree163 / 06 and subsequent amendments and supplements. Such statement must also be made by any external collaborators/consultants indicated by the competitor;
- a.5) under penalty of exclusion, insofar as applicable by virtue of the legal status of the candidate, that there are no persons who resigned from office in the year preceding the date of publication of Notice of Competition; or that there are persons who resigned from office in the aforesaid period, indicating the name, position, date of birth, address and tax code number, and that they are not in the condition provided for by art. 38 paragraph 1 letter. c) of Legislative Decree 163/2006 and subsequent amendments and supplements; or that they are in the conditions referred to in paragraph 1, letter c), art.38 of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements and that the competitor company/ies has/have taken appropriate measures for complete and effective dissociation from them. Dissociation must be proven by appropriate documentation. As a result of transactions for the sale, merger or rental of the company, "ceased" entities are also to be considered those in the offices indicated in art.38 paragraph 1 letter. c) who

have operated in the sold/merged company in the year preceding the date of publication of the Notice. This declaration must also be made by any external collaborators/consultants indicated by the Competitor;

- a.6) **under penalty of exclusion**, that they are not affected by the procedures in place relating to individual plans of emergence under art. 1, paragraph 14, of law 18/10/2001 no. 383, as replaced by Decree-Law 25/09/2002, no. 210, converted with amendments by law /22/11/2002, no. 266.
- a.7) **under penalty of exclusion**, the absence of the causes of exclusion from tender procedures under art. 41 of Legislative Decree 198/2006;
- a.8) **under penalty of exclusion**, the absence of the causes of exclusion from tender procedures under art. 44 of Legislative Decree 286/1998;
- a.9) under penalty of exclusion, the absence of the causes of exclusion from tender procedures under art. 53 paragraph 16-ter of Legislative decree 165/2001, as introduced by art. 1, paragraph 42, of law 190/2012, or further prohibitions to contract with the public administration in accordance with current legislation. Such statement must also be made by any external collaborators/consultants indicated by the Competitor;
- a.10) to authorise the Administration to use the fax as provided for by art. 79, paragraph 5-bis, of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements.
- a.11) with regard to economic operators having their established residence or domicile in countries included in the so-called "Black list" pursuant to the Ministry for the Economy and Finance Decree/04/05/1999 and the Decree of the Ministry for the Economy and Finance 21.11.2001, they are obliged, **under penalty of exclusion**, to produce the authorisation issued pursuant to the Ministerial Decree 14.12.2010 (art. 37 of 31.05.2010 no.78);
- a.12) under penalty of exclusion, (in the case of Group, Consortia or EEIG by the single parent company) the original or photocopy, accompanied by a statement of authenticity and a copy of a valid identity document, of the receipt proving the payment of the mandatory contribution pursuant to the Resolution of the Supervisory Authority of public contracts for works, services and supplies of 09/12/2014 and the relative operating instructions published on the Authority website at the address http://www.avcp.it/riscossioni.html of the amount of € 20.00 (twenty/00 Euro), to the said Authority, carried out in either of the following ways:

To make the payment candidates must register online with the Contributions Collection Service. The economic operator must log in to the Contributions Collection Service using the credentials issued and enter the CIG code identifying the procedure he/she wishes to take part in. The system allows the following methods of payment of the contribution:

The original receipt must be attached to the bid.

The reason for payment should indicate only the tax ID code used in the country of residence or registered office of the participant (e.g. VAT number) and the CIG of the procedure he/she wishes to participate in.

The foreign economic operator must attach the receipt of the bank transfer made to the bid.

b) insofar as applicable by virtue of the legal status of the candidate, the declarations referred to in sections b1), b2) and b3) below, made under penalty of exclusion by the following Parties: in case of a one-man company: the owner and technical director; in the case of an unlimited partnership: all the partners and the technical director; in the case of a limited partnership: all the partners and the technical director; in the case of other companies or consortia: all the directors vested with powers of representation and the technical director or the sole shareholder natural person, or, in the case of a company or consortium with less than four members, the signature of the majority shareholder should the same also be a natural person, certifying pursuant to the Presidential decree 445/00 and subsequent amendments and supplements. For the declarations referred to in this paragraph, should the signatory not be in possession of a digital signature, a scanned copy of the statement signed manually by the same and digitally signed by the legal representative or signatory agent of the company together with a scanned copy of the identity document signed digitally by the legal representative of the competitor company must be attached on the ANAS purchasing portal:

b.1) that they are not in the conditions provided for by article 38, paragraph 1, letters b) and c) of Legislative Decree no. 163/2006 and subsequent amendments and supplements and in particular stating that there are no pending proceedings against them for the application of preventive measures of supervision pursuant to art. 6 of Legislative Decree 159/2011; that no preventive measure of supervision in their regard have been provided for under art. 6 of Legislative Decree 159/2011; that in their regard, over the past five years, the effects of preventive supervision under art. 6 of Legislative Decree have not been extended 159/2011, imposed against a cohabitant; that in their regard there the are no reasons for disqualification under art. 67 of Legislative Decree 159/2011;

b. 2) in addition, the following further specific statement of assurance as to the absence of any final judgement, or conviction which has become irrevocable or ruling imposing the sentence requested, pursuant to article 444 of the code of criminal procedure, or alternatively, stating that such criminal sentences were passed, listing to such purpose any final judgement, or conviction which has become irrevocable or ruling imposing the sentence requested, regardless of any assessment of their seriousness, including those for which he/she has benefited from the non-mention pursuant to art. 38, paragraph 2, of Legislative decree 163/2006 and subsequent amendments and supplements, specifying the year they were committed, the crime, the laws violated, the Court where the judge issued the criminal sentence, the sanctions imposed.

b.3) that he/she was not a victim of crimes provided for and punished under articles 317 and 629 of the Criminal Code, aggravated under art. 7 of the Decree Law 13/05/1991 no. 152, converted, with amendments by Law 12/07/1991 no. 203 or, having been a victim of the crimes mentioned above, did not omit to report the incident to the judicial authorities, without prejudice to the cases under art. 4, paragraph 1, of Law 24/11/1981, no 689.

For the purposes of the statements relative to paragraphs b1) b2) and b3) reference is made in its entirety to the provisions of art. 38, paragraph 2, of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements.

The statements on discontinued subjects may be made by the legal representatives of the candidates, inasmuch as aware of the facts stated, pursuant to art. 47 of the Presidential Decree 445/2000 and subsequent amendments and supplements, if there are reasons that make it impossible to obtain the

statements from the parties concerned. Such statements must also be made by any external collaborators/consultants indicated by the Competitor.

c) in the case of incorporated temporary groupings of professionals or design firms, ordinary Consortia or EEIG, the relative deed of memorandum, statute or agreement; in the case of temporary groupings of professionals or design firms or ordinary consortia not yet incorporated, the declaration of commitment of the legal representatives of all the companies wishing to group, to incorporate themselves in the case of awarding of the contract, concurrently indicating the company to be designated as representative of the group. This commitment will be signed manually by all legal representatives as well as digitally by the single manager of the future group leader;

In the case of a candidate who is not established in Italy, the aforesaid declarations must be made and signed digitally by the interested party pursuant to art. 38, paragraph 5, of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements.

d) under penalty of exclusion, to accept without conditions or reserve of any type, all the rules and regulations contained in the Notice of Competition, in these Competition Regulations, in the annexes and in the relative replies to queries.

In this Competition the following provisions shall apply pursuant to art. 38, paragraph 2-bis and art. 46, paragraph 1-ter of Legislative Decree 163/2006, as introduced by art. 39 of Decree-Law 24 June 2014, no. 90, published in the OJ no. 144 of 24/06/2014.

Should it be ascertained at the moment of verification of the administrative documentation produced by competitors that essential elements and statements required by regulations of this Competition are missing, incomplete or present other essential irregularities, paragraph 1-ter of article 46 "rescue documentation" of the Code shall apply. In this case, the competitor who wishes to make use of such option shall pay the Contracting Authority, the amount, by way of financial penalty, of € 286,00 (two hundred eighty six/00 euro). The competitor will be allocated a period of 5 days to comply with the aforementioned integration of the missing documents. In the case of omitted payment of the penalty mentioned above, the procedures provided for by law for the recovery of the amounts due will be activated.

Failure or delayed fulfilment of the document request by the contracting authority will result in exclusion of the competitor from the subsequent phases of the Competition.

9.1 MANNER AND SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

Once filled in all administrative documents must be digitally signed and uploaded along with the files containing the non-authenticated photocopy of an identity document of the signatory.

The method of presentation of proposals envisaged for the procedure in question is the "Richiesta di offerta" RDO (Request for Proposals RFP) in a sealed, digital envelope. Competitors must submit their **Proposals exclusively online**, following registration on the portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it as instructed in the Notice of Competition. Competitors are therefore invited, if not yet registered, to complete their registration on the aforementioned portal as soon as possible in order to submit the online Bid within the deadline established.

Registration on the aforesaid portal must be made within 7 (seven) days prior to the deadline for the submission of tenders as in paragraph IV.4.3. of the Notice. After such date, registration cannot be guaranteed.

It should be specified that registration is a prerequisite for participation in the Competition and is free of charge.

To complete the registration, the competitor must follow the instructions in the "Area Fornitori" (Supplier Area) section of the ANAS Purchasing portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it.

In case of temporary groupings, registration on the ANAS Purchasing portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it must be performed solely by the group leader/agent. Even if the group leader/agent is already registered as an individual company on the ANAS Purchasing Portal, a new registration must be made as instructed below: in the "Ragione Sociale" (Business Name) field of the online registration form the initials "R.T.I" should be written followed by the name of the representative company and subsequently by that of the principal companies (e.g. "R.T.I Red/White/Green, where Red is the representative company).

In detail the report should address the following topics:

- Explanation of the reasons for the proposed solution and motivation of the architectural and techniques choices of the design;
- General description of the design solution from a technical and functional point of view;
- Adaptation of the solution proposed to the possible diverse physical (morphological, geo-technical, hydraulic etc.) seismic and environmental conditions present on the Italian territory;
- Indication of the structural solutions related to architectural proposals;
- Information on the construction phase (timing, space requirements, supplies, impact, etc.);
- Description of the characterization of the project in terms of insertion in the reference contexts and relationships with the surrounding built areas and the occupation of areas as well as with regard to interference with public services present and their solution;
- Description of the proposed solution as regards sustainability with particular reference to the protection of resources (limited power consumption, eco-efficient choice of construction materials, limitation of water consumption) and environmental protection (reduction of emissions of greenhouse gases, light and noise pollution);
- Description of the construction materials, devices and technologies used to minimize ordinary and/or extraordinary maintenance, including in relation to their availability and ease of installation through Life Cost Analysis;
- Circumstances which cannot be shown in the drawings;
- Guidelines for the preparation of the final design;
- Initial indications and measures relating to the protection of health and safety during construction and for drawing up safety plans;
- Preliminary report on the economic aspects of the project.

The Report may include images and drawings and must be contained in a file of max. of 50 pages in UNI A4 format in Arial 10 body font plus the cover on PDF files and must be digitally signed by the group leader.

b. Technical Report

The report shall include the development of specialised technical studies of the project with reference to the main technical standards, describe the investigations made and the characterisation of parts of the work in terms of blending in with the territory, justify the technical choices of the project in relation to the different evaluation criteria, also highlighting the possible alternatives and the reasons for such choices.

In particular, the works and related construction methods will be described and the preliminary technical sizing shown (supporting the typology and structural drawing). For tied-arch solutions, allowing a reduction of the structural thickness on the bigger spans below the bridge gradient and thus a lowering thereof with positive effects on blending in and the overall cost of the crossing, particular attention should be paid to cross-platform distribution.

From this point of view, the possibility of using standard lateral protection barriers seamlessly with any embankments/access viaducts is undoubtedly an advantage. However, if such a solution requires an excessive space dysfunctional for the type of proposal, alternative solutions may be accepted involving integration of restraint barriers with the artefact itself for the safety of users and the infrastructure itself.

The report will describe the construction phases and define the closing times of the underlying infrastructure, considering that in most cases overpasses must be built on existing roads in operation and that such time frames should be organised at night or on days with less traffic.

Information will be given regarding the selection criteria and the performance characteristics of the materials to be used for the execution of works. For the construction components in concrete and in metal, the environmental exposure classes and performance characteristics identified on the basis of information provided by the relevant UNI standard should be indicated. Information should also be

provided on the use of waste material deriving from the demolition of existing engineering works as material for the new construction.

- c. Drawings showing the accessibility and connections with the surrounding areas (urban, periurban, non-urbanised territory), the characterization of public spaces, the provision of open spaces and green areas relevant to the works
 - General layout in scale 1:2000;
 - Scale plans 1:1,000 and 1:500 enabling identification of all the distribution typological and functional features of the design, supplemented if necessary by details in different scales and tables relative to the technical parameters to be observed;
 - Sections, elevations and views on an appropriate scale for the description of both the artefacts and appurtenant spaces and accessories.

The drawings must be contained in n° 5 UNI A0 format tables oriented horizontally in a PDF file, digitally signed by the group leader.

d. Summary calculation of expenditure

The summary calculation of expenditure generated by PRIMUS, SRT or other compatible software format will be presented on PDF files, digitally signed by the group leader.

CHAPTER III-WORKS OF THE SELECTION PANEL -RESULTS OF THE COMPETITION

13. SELECTION PANEL

Under the combined provisions of articles 84 and 106 of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements, the Selection Panel is composed of five (5) members of international relevance, representing ANAS, the national boards of the professional registers, the academic and institutional world and professional world. The members of the Selection Panel are appointed after the deadline for the submission of the design proposals.

The Selection Panel is the same for the first and second phase of the Competition.

The following subjects may not form part of the Selection Panel:

- 1. The competitors, their spouses or cohabitants and their parents and relatives up to the fourth degree;
- 2. The employers and employees of competitors and those having an employment relationship or other known relationship with them.

The causes of abstention provided for by art. 51 of the Code of Civil Procedure will apply to the members of the Selection Panel.

Substitute members will also be appointed, should the necessity arise to replace one or more of the acting members.

If an acting regular member should declare his/her inability to attend the proceedings, the opening or the works of the Selection Panel, he/she will be permanently replaced by one of the substitute members chosen by the Chairman. To such purpose the substitute members will participate in the work of the Selection Panel, without the right to vote.

A secretary appointed by the Contracting Body, will be present during each Panel meeting to take minutes without holding any voting rights.

The Panel will be backed up in both phases of the competition by the Technical and Administrative Support Committee to check the compliance of the competitor's documentation with the formal administrative and technical requirements. The Members of the Technical-Administrative Support Committee will be chosen by ANAS and the meetings of such Committee will take place in private form.

Once the formal check is complete, the Technical and Administrative Committee will transmit the list of candidates to the operator of the platform who, on the basis of the information received, will provide the Panel, anonymously, with the design proposals admitted to the competition.

The Panel will hold its meetings in one or more private sessions; minutes of each will be recorded.

The final minutes of the second phase will include the ranking with all the scores of the competitors. Participants will be informed, in the manner indicated in paragraph 14 below, of the completion of the Panel's works.

The Panel of Judges takes its decisions by simple majority of those present, the decisions made by the Panel are binding for ANAS and are final.

The Panel is not allowed to present joint awards.

The final announcement of the winner and of the recipients of the awards and refunds is subject to the satisfactory verification of the statements made by the Contracting authority.

The appointment, and the composition of the Panel will be announced on the company websites indicated in paragraph 23 of these Regulations

In the first, as in the second phase, the Panel will operate according to the methods and procedures of the combined provisions of art 107 of Legislative Decree 163/06 and subsequent amendments and supplements and of art. 258, paragraph 2 of the Presidential Decree 207/10 and subsequent amendments and supplements.

14. PUBLIC MEETINGS

At the end of the first stage of the Competition the Panel of Judges, in a public meeting, will illustrate the project proposals submitted and will announce which projects (max. 10) will have been admitted to the second phase of the Competition.

At the end of the second phase, in a second public meeting, the Panel will announce the winners of the Competition and related ranking, as clarified in further detail in paragraph 17 below.

The day, time and place of the public meetings of the Competition will be notified by means of the "messages" function of the online Requests for Proposals feature, on the portal https://acquisti.stradeanas.it.

15. WORKS OF THE SELECTION PANEL - FIRST PHASE

In the first session, the Panel, after the administrative checks of the documentation submitted on-line and with reference to the design proposals of competitors admitted to the continuation of the proceedings, will determine the methodology of the works. The Panel will favour innovative ideas and the ability to solve complex problems.

The choice of design proposals admitted to the second phase of the Competition will be based on the following evaluation criteria

Quality and recognisability of the project as regards the architectural, functional aspects and its
applicability to different territorial situations (max. 50 points);
An integrated approach to energy and sustainability issues in the proposal submitted (max 30
points);
Quality of the proposal in terms of accessibility and connections with the surrounding areas (max.
20 noints)

The works of the Panel must be completed within 60 days of the deadline for submission of the documents.

16. WORKS OF THE SELECTION PANEL - THE SECOND PHASE

In the first private meeting, the Selection Panel will define the methodology of the works for the second phase of the Competition.

The Selection Panel will evaluate the proposals admitted on the basis of the following criteria:

- a) Quality of the project in terms of composition/architecture, recognisability and unique features (max. 30 points);
- b) Technical feasibility of the application of the design proposal in the different physical environmental, human and functional conditions present on the ANAS network; analysis of economic impact of the various possible applications (max. 25 points);
- c) Functional organisation of spaces for the insertion of technical-functional elements in the infrastructure (max. 10 points);

- d) Accessibility, connections/integration with the surrounding fabric as regards its relationship with the natural environment and the design of green areas (max. 10 points);
- e) Effectiveness of the communication plan for shared development and public participation in the design solutions (max. 10 points);
- f) Use of highly innovative materials and devices related to the reuse and recycling circuits of materials: the projects will also be evaluated for their ability to minimize routine and / or extraordinary maintenance, including in relation to the ready availability thereof and ease of installation (max. 10 points);
- g) Artwork and artistic-architectural features to be placed in the vicinity and / or in the areas pertaining to the overpass and its road links (max. 5 points).

The works of the Panel must be completed within 35 days of the deadline for submission of the documents.

Assessment during both the first and the second phases will be made based on the average of scores, ranging between zero and one, allocated at the discretion of each member of the selection panel; once the procedure for awarding discretionary scores is complete, the average of the scores allocated to each bid by all the panel members will be transformed into the final scores, giving the highest average a value of one and attributing such maximum average in proportion to the provisional averages previously calculated.

The total maximum score is 100 points.

17. ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE WINNER

The Panel, in a public meeting, will announce the winner of the Competition and the ranking of the participants of the second phase.

The day and time of the public meeting will be announced in the manner provided for in paragraph 14.

CHAPTER IV-FINAL REQUIREMENTS

18. PRIZES AND EXPENSE REFUNDS-OWNERSHIP OF THE DOCUMENTS

The winner of the competition will receive the amount of € **150,000.00** (gross of VAT and Pension fund) by way of a prize for the proposal and design submitted.

With this payment, as established by art. 99, paragraph 5 of Legislative Decree April 18, 2006 no. 163, ANAS assumes ownership of the winning idea and of the relative design.

The runner up will receive the amount of €. **75,000.00** (gross VAT and Pension fund) and the competitor awarded third place will receive the amount of €. **50,000.00** (gross VAT and Pension fund). Each of the following seven (7) competitors will be awarded a lump sum refund of €. **1,500.00** (gross VAT).

The payment of the prize and of the expense refund, as determined above, will be made within 90 (ninety) days of the date of enforcement of the administrative ruling approving the work of the Selection panel.

The payment of the award to the second and third ranked competitors obliges the latter towards ANAS for a period of 12 months, during which ANAS reserves to right acquire, in accordance with the ranking, the winning idea and relative design.
