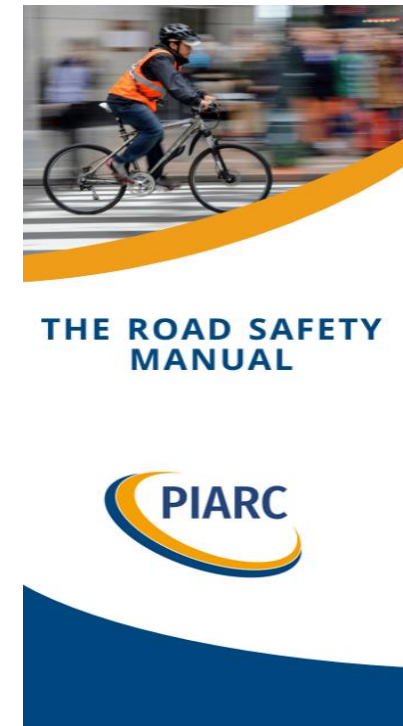
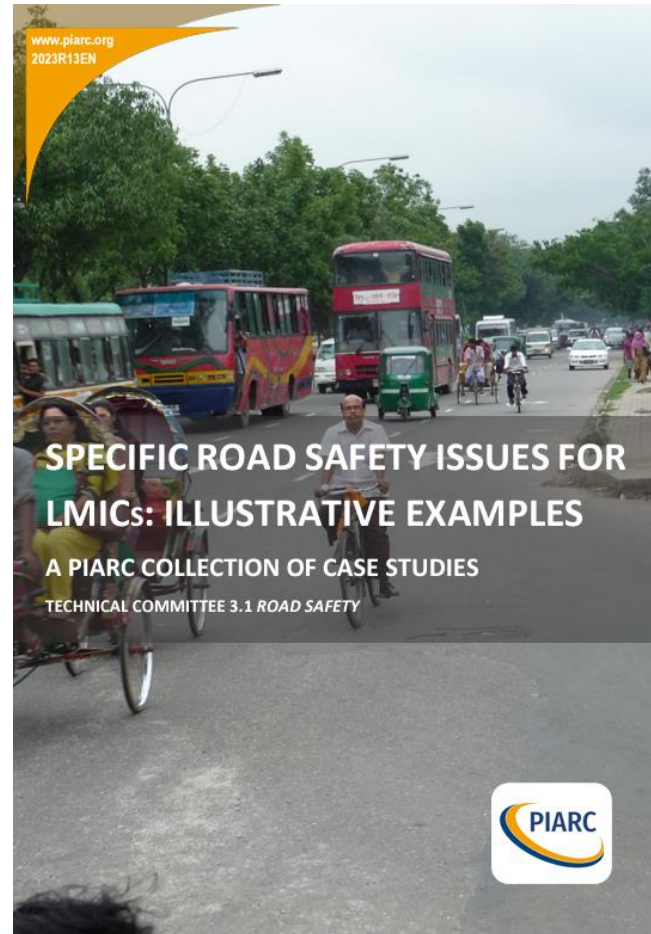


PIARC Project – Knowledge Sharing on Road Safety

- **Objective:** Outsource the crafting of materials and products to be used when conducting **knowledge-sharing activities with emphasis on LMIC.**
- **Based on PIARC material:** Road Safety Manual, reports, case studies etc.
- **Adapted to the needs of practitioners**
- The products include material for a 1-year knowledge sharing campaign:
 - Web-material; YouTube videos, LinkedIn, PIARC website announcement
 - Factsheets, presentations
 - 90-minute webinars (held last September)
 - Half-day workshop (at the PIARC World Road Congress in Prague last October)
- **Technical support:** USA, Australia, Canada Québec, South Africa, Sweden.
- **Contractor:** National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) and the Austrian Institute of Technology (AIT)
